





Anything ELSE you'd like to Add?



The SEARS are a really good new group from the Walsall area. They've got a really powerful female singer and have an album/12" out soon on Blurg records. Anyway, on with the interview.

How long HAS THE GROUP BEEN GOING AND WHAT'S THE LINEUP ?

We've been going since Jan. 81, various changes have taken place. The line-up is now
CORN-VOCALLS
DAVE-GUITAR
NICK-BASS
BATESY-DRUMS (latest new member).

Dave, Corny, & Nick were originally in the Sears all those years ago, although Dave did leave in 82, and then came back in 83.

WHAT IS THE BAND'S MAIN AIM?

To communicate, with people with something we all enjoy, we all enjoy playing in a band, and music is important. But obviously we feel strongly about our views, and therefore use the band, as a means of getting in touch with people - one of our main aims is to get in touch with everybody, well, as many people as possible, not just playing to like-minded people.

WHAT DO YOU TRY TO EXPRESS IN THE LYRICS?

Feeling, more than anything, we've got a song about rape, a song about war, you know the usual stuff, but some of our songs are about simple things such as "Hate" which is simply a song asking "Why do you?", and then there's boredom which is simply saying, you don't have to be. I Love, was a song, full of feeling, just saying, that you don't have to live in misery and depression, and there is love there if you look for it and want it. We've got a couple of songs about media roles, which is something we feel strongly about, you know, the male and female role. I get the feeling that our lyrics don't really say enough about how we feel about things, I think fan-zines, letters, are just an equal opportunity to express how we feel. Here is our latest song

DO YOU FEEL GIGS ARE IMPORTANT?

Yes,gigs are important,for us anyway,
you can tell how strongly a band feel
about what they are singing about,
which might not be important to some
people,but personally I find the audience
feeds me with inspiration,and I think
it seems obvious that we do care,
not only that,gigging is a chance to
meet lots of people,it's a gathering,
and anyway,we actually do like playing
gigs.

WOULD YOU LABEL YOURSELVES AS ANARCH-
ISTS,PACIFISTS,PUNKS etc?

If your going to put labels on your-
selves then make sure your definition
of a label is the same as ^{any} every-
one elses,for that reason,I wouldn't
pin a label on us,Another thing,views,
opinions change all the time.I'm hav-
ing doubts at the moment about Anar-
chism.I'd really like to believe that
one day we won't need a government,
but as I see all the people around me,
even on a small scale I find it hard
to imagine all their distorted,per-
verted minds just changing-we're wor-
king for individual change,a personal
growth of people,which are able to
reject the shit that's been fed them.
I've known and seen people change,
people that I know,so I can see this
happening,maybe we all could change.
I could call myself an anarchist,be-
cause I don't feel hopelessly pess-
imistic about people at the moment.

I think some people call it personal
anarchy,well we are looking and ask-
ing for personal freedom.

Pacifism? Well,I could call myself
one,although I'm not sure it's absol-
utely natural to be one,so by saying
that it's being a bit hypocritical.
We want peace,love,freedom,so,what
label is that?

I'm not sure what the label punk
means anymore,I like dressing up som-
etimes,and then at other times I think
it's bloody pointless,actually,half
the time I look 'normal'and no-one ever
takes the piss out of me,I'd say it's
because,it's not what you look like
it's who you are.If punk is an ap-
pearance,an identity for fashion,then no,
I wouldn't class myself as one.But I
like what's labelled as punk rock.

WHAT DO YOU THINK OF PUNK NOWADAYS?
THE UNIFORM AND GENERAL APATHY OF A
LOT OF PEOPLE?

I don't think there's that much ap-
athy,especially with 'punk'.I see more
and more people wanting to become
active.Yeah,things are becoming a
uniform.But I don't want to stand on
a pedestal and say,"your all not try-
ing,your all boring and useless,
you've got nothing to say".We all
have our moments of disillusionment
and apathy,but at the same time meet-
ing andto so many people,
you can feel the strength there real-
ly is.Punk can be like any other
thing,full of mindless,systematic
people,but I see more activity,more
ideas,more work put into working for
change than I do in any other fashion
fling,you'll always find the sheep to
the system,but there are people who
are saying no.I have to be optimistic
about punk,or whatever it is,if I did
-n't I would be miserable and depressed,
and that's no way to live.

Feminism is about freedom of choice, I don't believe it to be turning a women into machoism, I don't believe it to be stating that all men are bastards etc. nor do I believe it to be something that a woman has to do without men. I used to think that men and women are the same, and that it was only our bodies that are different, but if hormones affect the way we are, for instance P.M.T., then surely men must be different in some way, because they've got different levels of hormones. Maybe testosterone makes men more aggressive, maybe not, or maybe I'm sounding ridiculous.

But back to feminism. Well, I want to walk down the road without being insulted or whistled at, I want to walk alone at night without being frightened. I want people to treat me as an equal, I don't want to be treated as a second class citizen - "you're only a woman". I'd like to see more women aware of the shit they get, I feel so sorry for women when I see them accepting the role play.

Although, the media is responsible for a lot of our conditioning, it also tries to distort the whole idea of feminism, as soon as you label yourself a feminist then immediately people become frightened of you, they imagine the "macho lesbian" stereotype. Actually, all the women I've met, including lesbians, I've found none of them fitting into the stereotype laid down by the media. All of them have really good friendships with men, but just demand respect.

It's all to do with freedom of choice, doing what's right for the individual. I get angry when people talk to me and insult me because I am a woman, but I try and get my ideas across, and explain why I don't like being treated in this way.

It's men that need to change, take off their macho image, if only they weren't brought up to put on a front, to be insensitive and tough, maybe they wouldn't be so frightened of women - I just wish we could all see each other as individuals not men and women, but there again, because opposites are supposed to attract, maybe that's the roots of the oppression, relationships are often very sexist.

DO YOU THINK ANARCHY/AUTONOMY WOULD WORK?

My views and thoughts at the moment are no, only a couple of months ago I was saying yes. Recently, I've seen so many ordinary people, reeling out prejudices in nearly everything they say, there is a sense of aggression. I must be honest with myself, and I try to imagine all the media moulded people, living in harmony, and I can't. We've gone on too long, hating, being conditioned. If everyone had their freedom now, do you think they'd want it, or know what to do with it? So many people have lived with others being responsible for them- the attitude of blaming other people for wrong is a simple "it's not my responsibility". Maybe the reason Thatchers in power is because she takes on so much responsibility, exerts so much power, the system has conditioned us to need people telling us what to do. Oh fucking hell, it's so frightening. Yes, I do want change, and I'm working for it, I'll try and help people want freedom, and maybe I'll dream of anarchy, but it will only be a dream- I would like to have all the answers for anarchy, but I haven't, I would want it, but I can't see it.

DO YOU THINK IT'S BEST TO WORK WITH PEOPLE WHO MAY HAVE OPPOSING IDEALS BUT ARE WORKING FOR A CHANGE, OR HAVE NOTHING TO DO WITH THEM?

It depends what you mean by opposing ideals, like I wouldn't work with the N.F., but certainly I'd work with people for a change, if we didn't differ too much in our ideals. If the change we both wanted was the same, then why ever not? It's unity we're seeking after all.

DO YOU BELIEVE IN DIRECT ACTION? AND DO YOU THINK THAT FORCE MAY BE JUSTIFIABLE IN SOME CASES?

What is meant by direct action? If it means scratching a Rolls Royce, or blowing up anything you don't like I think it's pointless. But I think the A.L.F. are doing a brilliant job, I think direct action is justifiable in some cases, but if it's going to do anything worthwhile, it's got to be planned and thought out, it depends on what you want to achieve. I don't think getting arrested is a worthwhile occupation. Stop the City is good for getting us all together and letting off steam, but it also makes you realise the amount of force we are up against, how can we win peacefully, or hope to win at all? If you've got to fight with aggression then you're not changing peoples ideas. That's what we want, and that can only be achieved by tedious, non-violent ways. It's finding the strength in peoples hearts not their fists.

Yeah, we don't claim to be anything but people searching for the answers, we would like to see change, the system can, because we are the system, every-thing you do and say helps. Conditioning is hard to break free from, it's hard not to surround yourself with feelings of inadequacy, feelings of self doubt, ~~that~~ feelings that make it hard to love other people, peace must be obtained in your own hearts, if we all wanted to care, we all wanted to free ourselves from oppression, it would be easy.

Keep optimism and love in your hearts, it's no use getting depressed and unhappy about all the shit, if you want to show people an alternative way of living, then they're not going to take much notice if you're going round with a big frown on your face-people can make you happy or sad, if you give them shit, they're going to give you shit, so open up yourself, try and be real, try and be honest with yourself, and take the love that you give, give the love you take.





I saw the WAR TOYS play in their hometown of Ilfracombe, + was mucho impressed. I wrote off to 'em for their demo + also stuck some questions in. + what do ya know - They wrote back! far out eh? :)

How long has the band been going? What's the line-up?

The band has been going since around Sept. 83 in one form or another. The present line-up is Martin vocals, Chris guitar, Mark drums, Noggin bass.

What tapes do you have available? Where from etc? Any plans for a vinyl release? We have one track available on the NEVER SURRENDER Alternative Southwest tape but that's old hat to us now, we also have a four track demo and a nine track practise tape, and many various live tapes available from us at 76 Fore St. Ilfracombe, North Devon. (send a blank tape + sae). We hope to release a single in the near future.

I THINK YOUR MUSIC IS QUITE ORIGINAL, HOW WOULD YOU DESCRIBE IT? WHAT INFLUENCES DO YOU HAVE? WHAT BANDS DO YOU LIKE?

well, we find it hard to describe our music ourselves, we prefer people to make up their own minds about the sound instead of us telling them what it is. We try and create our own sound instead of trying to copy other people, although no matter how hard you try, influence will always seep in somewhere. Bands we like range from Bowie, Cockney Rebel and Velvet Underground, to Poison Girls, New Mod? - el Army, Discharge.

DO YOU BELIEVE IN USING THE GROUP TO PUT YOUR VIEWS ACROSS, OR ARE YOU MORE CONCERNED WITH THE MUSIC?

We feel music can be used in many ways, you can take a band for what they say, or you can take them just for their music. To us both are as important, although our lyrics are more concerned with personal politics (things that concern us) rather than party politics.

WHAT DO YOU WRITE ABOUT? WAR SEEMS TO BE ONE OF YOUR THEMES, ARE YOUR WORDS A BIT ABSTRACT AND SOMETIMES HARD TO UNDERSTAND (?), e.g. WHAT IS "OUTCRY" ABOUT? ARE YOU LOOKING FOR NEW APPROACHES TO TOPICS, OR IS THAT JUST THE WAY YOUR SONGS TURN OUT?

We write about many different things, mainly things that are confronted with in everyday life, i.e. emotions, feelings. The reason for the abstract is to try and make the songs more original and interesting, as we feel it is easy just to write fuck this and fuck that and that sort of thing. It just seems to be too predictable to write songs like that these days.

Outcry really is just about people talking behind each others backs if you don't fit into their way of life. I don't know if you have experienced this in your town, but where we live we are always getting blamed for things just for the way we live, i.e. we don't fit in with the majority thus we are talked about and outcast in a way.


We are always looking for topics, there's always something that will inspire to write a song.

!!- I THINK "UNEXCEPTABLE SITUATION" HAS GOOD WORDS, I PRESUME IT'S ABOUT A NUCLEAR WAR (?), CAN I WRITE THE LYRICS OUT?

Unexceptable situation is an anti war song, we try to describe the situation rather than just bluntly say fuck war. We would be glad if you would write the lyrics out.

WHAT BANDS DO YOU DO GIGS WITH? DO YOU DO A LOT OF GIGS? WHAT SORT OF CROWD REACTION DO YOU GET, COS YOU'RE NOT A USUAL 'PUNK' BAND?

We've played with many, various bands such as Vice Squad, A Heads, Subhumans, The Sears, Cult Maniax, Glee Club and various others in such places as Exeter, London, Plymouth, Barnstable. We have played around 30 gigs in the last year and the crowd reaction is different every time. We have gone down really well



Q. WHAT DID YOU THINK OF SCURGE?

A. TO BE HONEST I FOUND IT RATHER BORING. THE BANDS JUST SEEM TO BE SAYING SOMETHING THAT'S REALLY SAFE FOR PUNKS BANDS TO SAY (CRASS CLONES) THERE'S NOT ENOUGH JOKES.

Q. DO YOU HAVE A DIFFICULTY IN GETTING @ BANDS TO TAKE YOU SERIOUSLY?

A. I'VE NEVER REALLY THOUGHT OF THIS, I DON'T KNOW WHAT YOU MEAN BY @ BANDS. I THINK ANTI-SECT THINK WERE A BIT OF A JOKE COS WE GET DRUNK A LOT, BUT SO WHAT? I'M NOT SURE ABOUT TAKING US SERIOUSLY BUT I THINK A LOT OF BANDS TAKE THEMSELVES TOO SERIOUSLY. THEY THINK IF THEY STAND ON STAGE WITH LOTS OF @ + @ SIGNS AND POLITICAL MESSAGES BEHIND THEM, THEY THINK THEY'RE GONNA CHANGE THE WORLD, BUT LET'S FACE IT WHEN YOU'RE PLAYING TO PUNKS WHO KNOW IT ALL ALREADY AND YOU'RE ONLY SAYING WHAT CRASS SAID 5 YEARS AGO THEN YOU'RE GOING TO CHANGE FUCK ALL. I'M NOT SAYING WE DON'T CARE, BECAUSE WE DO, WE GO ON DEMONSTRATIONS AND I'M ACTIVE IN ANIMAL RIGHTS DIRECT ACTION AND INVOLVED IN BRISTOL PEACE CENTRE + SQUATTING GROUP BUT WE DON'T WALK AROUND WITH LONG FACES ALL THE TIME AND WE LIKE TO (SHOCK HORROR) ENJOY OURSELVES AND (GASP HOW UNCOOL) GET DRUNK AND (OH NO, HOW DECADENT) LAUGH AND BE HAPPY AND DANCE ABOUT TO MOTORHEAD AND SMOKE CHILLUMS.

Q. WHAT DID YOU THINK OF THE PORT TALBOT GIG?

(OVER 16 MONTHS AGO).

A. WE WENT ON TOO EARLY SO NOT ENOUGH PEOPLE WERE INTO THE SPIRIT OF IT AND SITTING DOWN SO THERE WASN'T ENOUGH ATMOSPHERE DURING OUR SET, BUT WE WENT TO THE PUB AFTER AND HAD SOME WELSH BITTER WHICH IS HOORAY.

Q. DID YOU ENJOY YOURSELVES IN ITALY?

A. YES, WE STAYED AT THE VIRUS IN MILAN WHICH IS A BIG SQUAT @ CENTRE TYPE PLACE THE PUNKS THERE ARE REALLY FRIENDLY AND THEY ARE MORE LIKE US THAN THE ENGLISH PUNKS. THEY'RE INTO THINGS LIKE DEMOS + FANZINES + DIRECT ACTION AND THEY ALSO LIKE TO GET DRUNK AND HAVE FUN AND MOST LIKE MOTORHEAD.

Q. WHATS THE BEST GIG YOU'VE DONE?

A. I THINK THE ONES IN ITALY WERE THE BEST AS THERE IS MORE ENTHUSIASM FOR US OVER THERE AND WE'RE REALLY EXCITED TO PLAYING IN A DIFFERENT COUNTRY SO WE PUT MORE INTO IT.

Q. DO YOU HAVE ANY HASSLES WITH THE LAW?

A. YES ALL THE TIME. STEVE + HIS GIRLFRIEND WERE TAKEN IN FOR A DRUG SEARCH, WE ALWAYS GET STOPPED IN OUR VAN AND QUESTIONED + ARRESTED FOR LITTLE OR NO REASON. FOR EXAMPLE I HAVE BEEN CHARGED WITH ATTEMPTED THEFT BECAUSE





I'd heard a lot of good reports about WRETCHED, and I couldn't wait to hear them. When I eventually got to listen to the "IN NOME DEL LORO POTERE..." "E.P. yeceeeaaarrgh!!! realised this was not something to 'like' or 'dislike', it was something to EXPERIENCE!

Erupting from Milano in Italy, this band beat the word 'thrash' into submission. Intense, powerful, FAST, manic, bonkers, these are words that fly through your head while writhing about on the floor. Get the picture? Here's some questions I sent GIANMARIO the singer, many thanks to him for the answers and taking the trouble to reply in English (maybe you'd like to write to him in Italian?!).

HOW LONG HAS WRETCHED BEEN GOING? WHAT IS THE LINE-UP?
The band was born in Oct. 81, and now the Wretched are... FABIO, BASS/GIANMARIO, vocals/CREMA, DRUMS/DANIELLE, GUITAR. Of the old line up now there is just my brother, the bass player, because the Wretched... the vocalist in Jan. 82, the guitarist in Aug. 83, and the drummer in Dec. 83. Before Wretched Daniele played the guitar in the Italian INDIGESTI now split, and Crema in STALAG 13 from BOLOGNA, who made an e.p. for the ATTACK RECORDS.

WHAT RECORDS AND TAPES DO YOU HAVE OUT? HOW MUCH DO THEY COST? WHERE CAN PEOPLE GET THEM FROM?

We made 3 e.p.s. The first in Sept. 83 with the Italian INDIGESTI (six tracks for each band), the second in March 83 with 8 tracks "IN NOME DEL LORO POTERE...", and the third in April 84 with 5 tracks "FINZA MAI?". We appear also in some live tapes (the last is "UNA NOTTE D'ANARCHIA" of April 84). Now we are working on 12" out in October with 14/15 songs. We sell our records for 1000 lire (about 40 pence) because we don't want to gain and exploit the punx. We have no label and no commercial distribution because we don't want no any manager or fuckin' bastard who want to use your life and your activities to make money and glory(?). We sell our records in the concerts and no fucking records shops have our records. A lot of our friends sell for us our records in Italy and in other countries and we would like to thank you all.

DID YOU ENJOY PLAYING IN BRITAIN? HOW DO GIGS IN BRITAIN COMPARE WITH ONES IN ITALY?

We liked to play in England two months ago. The people are very friendly and good, and we hope to play there again in the future. No difference between gigs in England + in Italy, just the people cannot understand the simple words because we speak a different language. In the records we sold in the gigs we put leaflets with the translation of our songs. But-----the music unite all of us!

We hope soon. We have contacts with Disorder+Varrukers to play again there.
Now we arranged for the beginning of July some gigs for the Varrukers and so
(we already spoke with them) we hope they make the same for Wretched.
Disorder are good good, our friends. They must play in Italy in June, but I
think they had a lot of problems because nobody arrived here. We hope they
can come here again! It's very good to organise the gigs without promoters
or managers who want just to gain and to exploit you! We played in Germany
in December '83 and we also liked that little "tour" there and we hope to play
again also in Germany.

WHAT IS THE PUNK SCENE LIKE IN YOUR AREA? DO YOU HAVE MANY GIGS? ARE THERE
ANY FANZINES?

The punk scene is very great(?) now here. There are a lot of punk very united
and very angry against the system. Also the bands are very good, and just
some bands made records or tapes for big label not independent, and I don't
like them! All the rest of the bands make records and tapes for independent
label (the only one is ATTACK RECORDS) of with the help of nobody and it's
very good. Now we had a lot of ~~trouble~~ problems because the police closed
one month ago our big squat VIRUS to destroy us and to stop the activi-
ties against the power, the war, the oppression, that the punk made. But we are
not dead, we are more united and more angry than before and now we have a
squat (but not so big like the old) to play and a house for the people who
lived in the old squat (write here for every info you want - VIRUS/ENTRO
SOCIALS CARIMADRI/CORSO GARIBOLDI 19/20121 MILANO). About your question
about how many gigs we made, we made 40/50 gigs here in Italy and NOT in
fucking rock club or other shit. Here is very difficult to play because
nobody wants the punk in my area. I like CORRA and RAPPRESAGLIA, IMPACT from
FERRARE, BLUES ARSE from UDINE and SILENT from BOLOGNA but there are a lot
of bands very good. The best fanzine is T.V.O.R (STEFANO VALLI, VIA M. 210/28,
21100 CREMA, ITALY), but there are a lot.

WHAT ARE YOUR MAIN PROBLEMS?

Our songs are on our problem, our fucking hard(?) life, on our will to not
join the army and will to fight the fuckin bastards who want to use your
life to satisfy their wishes of power and glory, on our need of peace and
freedom and equality. All our songs we send a message around and we try to
tell also to the people that they must understand their lives. They must
stand up and fight if they want to live not in the shit.

WHAT ARE YOUR PLANS FOR THE FUTURE? ANY MORE GIGS? ANY MORE
TO DO? Meeting our activities and we hope also that all the punk will
unite to fight the same enemies. Always against the power!
